

# Not in the recycling bin!

The yellow-lid kerbside bin is used to collect household items for recycling. After the bins are emptied, the contents are taken to NAWMA's Material Recovery Facility (MRF). A team of energetic sorters then separate all the materials by hand.

**Please consider our staff and keep the following items out of your recycling bin.**



**Food scraps** → Green-lid bin



**Nappies** → Red-lid bin



**Soft plastics** → A supermarket Redcycle collection point or the red-lid bin



**Gas bottles & batteries** → Free drop-off at a NAWMA Resource Recovery Centre



**Textiles** → Good quality - donate  
Unusable - red-lid bin



**Crockery** → Good quality - donate  
Unusable - red-lid bin
