NAWMA will collect the contents of your FOGO bin every fortnight (opposite week to your recycling bin).

If you live in the **City of Playford** you can download the free **My Playford** app to receive bin collection notifications.



Collecting Food Scraps with a Kitchen Caddy

Line your caddy with a compostable* bag. Compostable bags will completely decompose along with the organic material you have collected in your caddy, they do not contain any plastic and will not contaminate the contents of your FOGO bin.







*Compostable bags and packaging should be certified to Australian Standard AS 4736 or AS 5810. Look for the logos. Scan the QR Code for more information and tips.
