## Household Recycling

The yellow-lid bin is for recyclable material only.  
Remember, real people sort your recycling, and  
your choices help keep them safe.



Steel cans



Paper and cardboard



Aluminium cans  
and foil



Glass jars and  
bottles



Rigid plastic  
containers



No soft plastics,  
batteries or e-waste

Please make sure containers are empty and rinsed.



# Food and Garden Organics (FOGO)

This material is turned into valuable compost to be used on our local farms and gardens.



**Food scraps**  
Raw and cooked



**Compostable food and beverage packaging**



**Human and pet hair**



**Leaves, sticks and branches**  
(Limit 100mm diameter)



**Tea bags and ground coffee**



**Shredded paper, tissues and paper towel**



Please do not place regular plastic in the green-lid bin - certified compostable packaging only.

**Feed your Green Bin.**

# Using your Kitchen Caddy



An easy way to collect your food scraps and other compostable materials in your home.

- 1 Line your caddy with a compostable bag.\*
- 2 Fill your caddy with food scraps and paper towel, coffee grounds and tea bags.
- 3 Every 2-3 days (or when full), remove the compostable bag and place into your green-lid bin.

\* Or place your food scraps straight into the green-lid bin.

Your council may provide compostable liners for free, or reuse the compostable produce bags from supermarkets.

Look for the certified compostable logo to check if bags or packaging can go in the green-lid bin.

**This material goes to landfill.**

Nappies, sanitary products, gloves and masks



Hoses and PVC piping



Polystyrene



Soft plastics
